- Boy scout camp out weekend was awesome and they opened all the trails for the club.
 They set up their camp and when they left, there was no trace of them...they disappeared like Navy Seals. BSA troop 161 also asked for list of projects from BJCC and they would consider finishing them as part of Eagle Scout Projects.

New Business

- We need more member involvement for chair/committee positions.
- AB said we are trying for 5-person volunteer committee for the Cornhole/pig roast tournament.
- We are trying for a fundraising and corporate sponsorship committee as well.
- Head Greenskeeper position available to coordinate grass cutting at the club. You could
 get volunteer hours for this effort. The club can provide a key to get mower, and the gas
 is provided by the club. AB is going to email the sign-up sheet to the members, in
 addition to the one at the food stand.
- Yard sale idea was discussed for the club possibly as selling a space for your own table and stuff for \$10.
- AB indicated that the dock is in bad shape. We need to start ear-marking money to replace and maybe put on the BSA Eagle Scout project list. That said, it is not currently safe.
